JUVENILE JUSTICE BOARD (JJBs) IN NCT OF DELHI**

Online applications are invited for the 02 Honorary posts of Members in the various Juvenile Justice Boards in NCT of Delhi as per Section-4 of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 and Rules 4,5 & 88 of Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Model Rules, 2016.

The applications shall be accepted w.e.f 15.06.2020 (11:00 AM) to 24.06.2020. After scrutiny of applications the list of eligible shortlisted candidates shall be displayed on the website of the Department. The eligible applicants are advised to refer to the web portal www.wcddel.in for terms of reference of the appointment and eligibility criteria and refer web portal <http://cams.wcddel.in> for applying online . Candidates are advised to refer to Department's Notice Board/Website for any updates in this regard.

Note – No other mode of applications except online shall be entertained by the Department. The Department also reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of vacancies at any point of time.

Terms of Reference

1. The candidates applying for the 02 Honorary post of Member of the Juvenile Justice Board should be above 35 years of age as on last date of application. He shall also have atleast 07yrs of experience of working with children in the field of education, health or welfare activities or should be a practicing professional with a degree in Child Psychology or psychiatry or sociology in the field of law.
2. The Member of the Board will be paid honorarium of Rs. 3500/- per sitting or as decided by the Government.
3. The duties of Juvenile Justice Board call for full time sitting from 10:00 AM to 5:00 PM on all working days.
4. A Member of a Board shall be eligible for appointment of maximum two terms, which shall not be continuous.
5. In addition to this, the State Government has the power to terminate the services of any Member of JJB at any point of time in accordance with the provisions of the Juvenile Justice (Care & Protection of Children) Act, 2015 & Rules there under.
6. Member selected by the Selection Committee should meet the criteria as envisaged in Sub-Rule 5 of Rule 88 of the JJ(CPC) Model Rules, 2016.
