programme of street children had been merged into the new Integrated Child Protection Scheme of Ministry of WCD. This case may be referred to the CPU with remarks that these cases of the said NGOs were found suitable by the GIA Committee for recommendation to the Ministry under said pre-existing programme for which Deptt of WCD, GNCT of Delhi had already invited and processed the applications.

#### **COMMON OBSERVATIONS FOR RECOMMENDED CASES:**

The GIA Committee observed that the above listed cases are recommended to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India and Ministry of Women & Child Development, Govt. of India with the following common observations:-

- 1. In view of the fact that the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India has decided State-wise notional allocation under different GIA schemes. The amount of GIA for the recommended cases may be decided as per the proportion of actual grant disbursed last year.
- 2. The quantum amount of GIA may be decided by the Recommendation Committee/Project Sanctioning Committee at Govt. of India after looking into the utilization of the previous grants.
- 3. The sanction be based strictly in accordance with norms of the scheme as applicable to the respective case.
