

**MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF GRANT-IN-AID COMMITTEE**  
**HELD ON 23.3.12**

A meeting of the GIA Committee was held on 23.3.12 at 04.30 P.M. under the chairmanship of Director (WCD) to consider the GIA cases under the schemes of Ministries of Social Justice & Empowerment, and Women & Child Development, Govt. of India, for the year 2011-12.

These meetings were attended by the following officers:-

The Distt. Officer/ representative from the Distt. Office (NW-II) attended the meeting, who had carried out the scrutiny and inspection of the GIA proposals which were, project location-wise, falling in his respective jurisdiction. He brought and presented the cases before the GIA Committee along with summary containing brief findings and results on the cases.

**CASES RECOMMENDED**

During the meeting, the GIA Committee found the following cases suitable for recommendation to the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment & Women & Child Development, Govt. of India subject to certain common conditions and case specific conditions, which are subsequently detailed below:-

**COMMON OBSERVATIONS FOR RECOMMENDED CASES:**

The GIA Committee observed that the above listed cases are recommended to Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India with the following common observations:-

1. In view of the fact that the Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment, Govt. of India has decided State-wise notional allocation under different GIA schemes, the amount of GIA for the recommended cases may be decided as per the proportion of actual grant disbursed last year.
2. The quantum amount of GIA may be decided by the Recommendation Committee/Project Sanctioning Committee at Govt. of India after looking into the utilization of the previous grants.
3. The sanction be based strictly in accordance with norms of the scheme as applicable to the respective case.

**CASE SPECIFIC CONDITIONS:**

**1. SOCIETY FOR PROMOTION OF YOUTH & MASSES (SPYM):**

In the matter of the above mentioned organization for its project proposal of 50 Bedded Detox Centre for homeless/ street based drug users, the Committee observes that the organization has yet to establish the said Detox centre for the target group. In fact the organization conveyed to the Department as late as 20<sup>th</sup> March,2012 about the changed location of its proposed centre by enclosing copies of letters dated 18.01.2012 and 07.12.2011 addressed to the Chairperson of the organization by Delhi Urban Shelter Improvement Board, GNCT of Delhi regarding allotment of space in Community Centre, Night Shelter etc.

Going through these letters and keeping in view the satisfactory performance and experience of its already established on-going projects, the Committee finds the project proposal of the organization suitable for recommendation only for 15 Bedded Drug De Addiction centre at DUSIB Community Centre on Ist and IInd floor at Babu Park, Kotla Mubarakpur.

**2. TURNING POINT FOUNDATION**

The Committee observes that the NGO had applied for 30 Bedded Drug De Addiction Centre at the proposed location of Bank street, Nehru Enclave, Alipur, Delhi. Two inspections of the NGOs said proposal were necessitated in view of differential observations on the adequacy of space available with the NGO and number of beds found in place at the time of inspection. There were inter-year and intra-year differences. Therefore, in view of such field level findings, the Committee finds the application/ proposal of the NGO suitable for recommendation only for 15 Bedded Drug De Addiction Centre at the above detailed location.

The Committee further observes that this recommendation is subject to the condition that the NGO submits to the Ministry, through the Chairperson of the GIA Committee, satisfactory clarification about the nature/ status of its proposed location for the centre. It should clarify the nature/ status of the proposed building for the centre since it mentioned in its application that it is

‘ON LEASE’ whereas its submits a copy of Rent Agreement of the said location, that too, without proper exact details of the address i.e. Plot No. House No. etc.

3. CHETANALAYA,

The project proposal of the above cited NGO is recommended only in view of the findings of District field level officers and DSWO(North West-II) to the effect that “ the population of the (Mukundpur) vicinity is very high and the (already) functional GRC ( under Mission Convergence) is not sufficient to cover all the beneficiaries in the area. There is no chance of duplicacy of beneficiaries”. The Project Sanctioning Committee of the Ministry may however, consider this sanction and release of the grant to the NGO for its said project only until there is no suitable expansion of GRC activities in the proposed area of Mukundpur by the Mission Convergence, Govt. of NCT of Delhi.
